

CODE RED FIRE

- 1. Rescue anyone in immediate danger.
- 2. Isolate fire by closing doors and windows.
- 3. Dial 000 Fire.
- 4. Extinguish fire if safe to do so.
- 5. Await directions from emergency controller –external emergency service provider.

CODE ORANGE EVACUATION

- 1. Order to evacuate will be given by staff.
- 2. Await directions from emergency controller external emergency service provider.

CODE PURPLE BOMB/ARSON THREAT

On receiving phone call, alert another staff member.

- 1. Keep caller talking DO NOT HANG UP.
- 2. Dial 000 Police.
- 3. If suspect item DO NOT TOUCH. Isolate area.
- 4. Await directions from emergency controller external emergency service provider.

CODE BLUE MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- 1. Call for assistance of other staff member.
- 2. Commence first aid and/or CPR.
- 3. Dial 000 Ambulance.
- 4. Fire Warden will co-ordinate response.

CODE BLACK PERSONAL THREAT

- 1. Do not confront or withhold valuables, money etc if demanded.
- 2. Observe offender for identification purposes.
- 3. Dial 000 Police when possible and safe to do so.

CODE YELLOW INTERNAL EMERGENCY/BREACH OF SECURITY

Gas Leak, Burst Water Main, Chemical Spill, Electrical Supply Failure, Person Trapped, Building Collapse, etc.

- 1. Dial 000 Police.
- 2. Evacuate office/building if necessary.
- 3. Await directions from Emergency controller external emergency service provider.

ALL CLEAR

Authorised by emergency controller – external emergency service provider, and announced on completion of all emergency responses.
