Vacuum Cleaners

Small light weight barrel style or stick vacuum cleaners are preferred, as shown below. Stick vacuum MUST have an on/off switch, not a switch to be held down to use. No upright vacuums are to be used due to compliance with Occupational Health and Safety Requirements.



Your vacuum cleaner should have the following features:

- An adjustable wand
- A flexible hose
- Be in good working order
- Well Maintained
- Easy to empty
- Have good suction
- Easy to move around
- Be stored at a height and in a location which can be safely accessed by the Home Care Officer
