Ian has many interests, but the three that he loves most are: "Fishing, trucks and the bombers."

"I catch trout on the river, and I've been out on the ocean once or twice on a boat."

Growing up on a beef cattle farm, he also used to work at the abbatoir. "I swept floors, and stuff like that. As a student. I was there for 11 years – I quit 13 times," he laughs. "I knew the boss really well. I'll never forget his name. Lovely fella."





Ian has done a bit of everything! When asked what other jobs he'd had, Ian said, "I worked at Mark's Timber in Warragul, and Clayton South. Building lots of things. The Chrissy trees in Warragul. I also picked grapes up in Mildura. That was good. Green grapes."

A passionate bombers fan, Ian sported a hat in the black and red stripes. He says he's been a supporter his whole life.

Navigating life without his late family has been a challenge for Ian. But he continues to see the beauty in every day, and in the people around him.

"Third day of sunshine," he says, "nice blue sky. Yesterday there was one tiny cloud. Just one."
