WINTER RECIPE

Ingredients (10)

- 1.2 tbsp olive oil
- 2.1 leek, halved, washed, thinly sliced
- 3.2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 4.1 large carrot, peeled, diced
- 5.2 sticks celery, diced
- 6.2 small zucchini, diced
- 7.1 swede or turnip, peeled, diced
- 8.11/4 cups dry soup mix, rinsed (see note)
- 9.8 cups chicken stock
- 10.1kg Coles RSPCA approved free range chicken lovely legs

Method

Step 1

Heat 2 tbsp olive oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add 1 leek, halved, washed, thinly sliced and 2 garlic cloves, crushed. Cook, stirring, for 2 minutes or until soft but not coloured. Add 1 large carrot, peeled, diced, 2 sticks celery, diced, 2 small zucchini, diced and 1 swede or turnip, peeled, diced. Cook for 2 minutes. Stir in 1 1/4 cups dry soup mix, rinsed (we used a dry soup mix comprising of peas, barley and lentils), 8 cups chicken stock, 1kg free range chicken lovely legs and 1 cup cold water. Increase heat to high. Bring to the boil.

Step 2

Reduce heat to low. Simmer, partially covered, stirring occasionally, for 1 hour or until soup mix and vegetables are tender.

Step 3

Remove chicken legs from soup. Allow to cool slightly. Remove meat from bones. Roughly chop chicken meat and add to soup. Season with salt and pepper. Ladle soup into warmed bowls. Serve.
